Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2009-2010 educational progress for the Bridgeport-Spaulding Community School District and our schools. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and some requirements of state laws; however, our staff is available to help you understand this information. Please contact Superintendent Gloria J. Rubis for help if you need assistance.

## **Student Assessment Data– Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP), Michigan Merit Exam (MME), and Michigan's Alternative Assessment Program (MI-Access)**

- Presents achievement data for English language arts and mathematics for grades 3 to 8 (MEAP), for grade 11 (MME) and science for grades 5 and 8 compared to targets for all students as well as subgroups of students
- Provides achievement data for English language arts, mathematics and science for students with significant disabilities (MI-Access) compared to targets for all students with disabilities as well as subgroups of students
- Helps readers understand achievement progress within schools and compare these to district and state achievement

## **Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) – Detail Data and Status**

Provides information from assessments, graduation and attendance rates and AYP status in relation to four criteria:

- The district must test 95% of students in total and in each required subgroup
- The district must attain achievement goals in English language arts and mathematics or reduce the percentage of students in the non-proficient category of achievement significantly ("safe harbor") annually
- The district must attain achievement goals for each subgroup that has at least 30 students in the group
- The district must meet or exceed the other academic indicators set by the state: graduation rate for high schools and attendance rate for elementary and middle schools

## **Teacher Quality Data**

- Identifies teacher qualifications at district and school levels
- Reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes

**NAEP Data (National Assessment of Educational Progress)**

- Provides state results of the national assessment in mathematics and reading every other year in grades 4 and 8
- Cannot be compared with MEAP results for grades 4 and 8 because there are no national standards.

**Other important information:**

- Students are assigned to each school based on their grade level.
- The 3 – 5 year school improvement plan is in process.
- The specialized schools servicing the district are as follows: Millet Learning Center, is operated by the Saginaw Intermediate School District. It serves students with special needs. Saginaw Career Complex is operated by the School District of the City of Saginaw. It provides programs and services in vocational and technical courses of study for high school students. Saginaw Arts and Sciences Academy is operated by the School District of the City of Saginaw. The program provides enhanced academic services to students who qualify. Hillier Educational Center provides services to students with severe emotional impairment. This countywide program is offered by the School District of the City of Saginaw. It assists students in developing personal confidence, socially acceptable behavior, and the skills necessary to become responsible individuals. Students are placed in the program through the IEPC process.
- Copies of the district's core curriculum are at the Educational Services Center, in each building and on the district's website.
- Parent-Teacher Conference participation was 16% at the high school, 73% at the middle school, 92% at Atkins elementary and 96% at Thomas White.
- 13 students were enrolled in postsecondary courses. AP English and AP Government were offered at BHS. 23 students were enrolled in those classes.

For 2009-2010, Bridgeport-Spaulding Community School District made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. All schools in the district also made AYP. None of our schools were identified for school improvement, corrective action or restructuring.

We are proud of our academic progress. Highly qualified, dedicated staff members work as a team to utilize best-practices and differentiated instruction. Relevant experiences are essential parts of classroom instruction. Administration understands the need for current professional development. We believe in the future of our students!
